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BACKGROUND


Sharp critique in national reviews of Swedish forensic psychiatry:

Lack of transparency & evidence-based practice



Need for national research programme

METHODS



PURPOSE & AIMS

Provide a base for the development of evidence-based practice in Swedish forensic psychiatry;

- 1) Determine important areas for intervention,
- 2) Clarify preconditions for, importance of and implications of, user involvement
- 3) Develop, adapt and evaluate treatment methods for forensic psychiatry, and
- 4) Initiate a national platform for transdisciplinary forensic psychiatric research.
